
THE FERRY DOCK REVITALIZATION PROJECT

CURRENT COMMUNITY FERRY DOCK CONCERNS:

- Ferry dock is run down and deteriorating
- Preservation of its historical significance
- Water and pumping access for fire boats

WHAT COULD BE IMPROVED OR ADDED:

- Sun / rain shelter / pavilion
- Ladders into the water
- Subway grate over the ferry ramp
- Historic sculpture of antique automobile
- Landscaping grass, flowers and shrubs
- Pumping station for fire trucks (Fire Department responsibility)
- Golf cart parking
- Cost estimate including all changes \$350K

THE COVE SAFETY / ACCESSIBILITY PROJECT

CURRENT COMMUNITY COVE CONCERNS:


- Water accessibility (young children, seniors & others)
- Traffic and parking proximity to play area / water
- Preservation of land and natural environment

WHAT COULD BE IMPROVED OR ADDED:

- Wood guardrail between road / parking and play areas
- Reconfiguration of stairs to the water (same location)
- Extend walking trail over rocks to Zephyr St. (access road)
- Accessibility catwalk to shallows / beach at the river
- One handicap parking space
- Planting of native vegetation to slow erosion
- Work with NYS to possibly resolve golf course runoff
- Cost estimate including all changes \$285K

WHAT HAS THE FOUNDATION DONE SO FAR?

Conducted land surveys and consulted with DEC and Army Corp to test feasibility Thought starter renderings for both the Cove and the Ferry Dock

NEXT STEPS:

- Community Presentation and Q&A. Saturday July 10th following Cottage Owners Meeting
- Community review of the projects will continue throughout the summer
- In September, all feedback will be compiled and reviewed
- The Foundation will consult with the Land Use/Waterfront Committee, the Preservation Board and the Corporation Board to share the results and discuss next steps
- Results will be shared with Community
