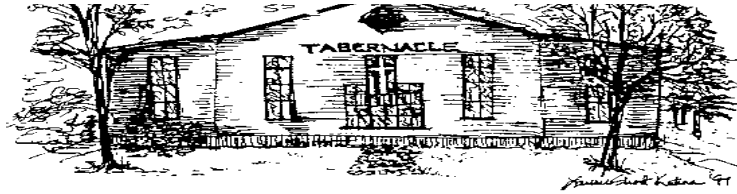

- **The Guzzle (315-203-2166)** now open from noon to 8pm (*closed Mondays & Tuesdays*).
- **The Wellesley Hotel Restaurant (315-482-3698)** is open for fine dining from 5pm ‘til 9pm (*closed Mondays & Tuesdays*). After Labor Day, the Restaurant will be open on weekends through September.
- **The Wellesley Hotel Pub** is open Wednesday, Thursday, and Sunday from 8pm to 11:30pm, and on Friday and Saturday, from 8pm ‘til 12:30am (*closed Monday & Tuesdays*). After Labor Day, the Pub will be open on weekends through September.
- **Lodging at the Wellesley Hotel (315-482-2576)** has accommodations available though mid-September!
- The **TIP Gas Dock (315-222-8611)** is open with on-call service.
- **TIP Security** personnel will remain on staff through Labor Day.
