T.I. PARK CORPORATION CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION & LICENSING FORM

All contractors and sub-contractors working in Thousand Island Park must be registered with the Corporation Office. If a contractor or sub/contractor is found working in TI Park without a valid T. I. Park Corporation license, a Stop Work Order will be issued. The registration and licensing procedures are listed below.

1.) Registration Form

• Complete and submit this form to the Corporation Office.

2.) Contractor License Fee

• The fee is currently \$250 per year for non-resident contractors and \$150 per year for resident contractors whose name is listed on a current T.I. Park Cottage Site Lease.

3.) Certificate(s) of Insurance

• Submit a current liability insurance certificate & current worker's compensation certificate if applicable. Insurance must have limits of no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate.
